

### DOCKSIDE LOCATION

Chelsea Creek is located in central London, just off the King's Road. It is situated on the north bank of the River Thames, adjacent to fashionable Chelsea Harbour and Imperial Wharf. 
## ARCHITECTURE BY SQUIRE & PARTNERS

The architecture of Chelsea Creek is inspired by the canal-side architecture of Amsterdam and Copenhagen. The masterplan is composed of long, linear blocks that allow dual aspect water views from homes, as well as creating easy access to the water. The buildings are clad in a mix of brick and metal, with balconies that provide residents with outdoor space.











The lobby is spacious and well-lit, with floor-to-ceiling windows that let in plenty of natural light. The walls are finished in a warm, neutral color, and the furniture is upholstered in luxurious fabrics. There is a large reception desk where residents can check in and out, as well as a concierge who can help with any of their needs. There is also a private residents' lounge that is available for private events.




